

Carol spends 17 hours in a 2-week period practicing her culinary skills. How many hours does she practice in 5 weeks?

Carol spends 52.5 hours practicing her culinary skills in a 5 week period.

$17 \times 2 = 44$ hours for 4 weeks

$17 / 2 = 8.5$ for 1 week (half of 2 week period)

$44 + 8.5 = 52.5$
