f=18
f-x
m+x
f-x=7
so substitute f=18 for f in f-x=7
18-x=7
add x to both sides
18=7+x
subtract 7 from both sides
11=x
faye gave 11 stickers to martin

 $j=2f$
we know that $f=7$ so we substitute $f=7$ for f in the equation
